The role of the President is to lead each member of the executive and aid them in their roles and goals throughout the year, take a lead on international governance and also to guide the direction of EYPUK alongside the Committee leadership. They should ensure that the whole Alumni Association Executive is the front face of EYPUK, and are approachable to the wider alumni network over the course of their term, especially to those who are newer members, and ensure that there is clear communication between the AA Executive and the Board of Trustees.

Generally speaking the role of President is a flexible one, traditionally being a more facilitative and supportive role, rather than one with a clear list of responsibilities and tasks. Below is an outline of some of the roles the President will undertake, as well as the skills needed to fulfil the role successfully, but this is in no way a definitive list since the role is highly flexible.

The desired skill set for the President:

- Organisation
- Effective communication
- Leadership
- Ability to plan the year and the events, managing time well
- Open and approachable

The roles which they will be undertaking:

- Helping to organise EYPUK's Alumni Training Weekend for the academic year 2019/20;
- Communicating and facilitating communication with the wider alumni network and the Board of Trustees;
- Representing EYPUK to the wider alumni network;
- Expanding EYPUK's alumni opportunities and the events open to them;
- Ensuring a cohesive AA Exec is formed;
- Supporting each member of the AA Exec throughout the year;
- Developing and implementing EYPUK's long term strategy;
- Maintaining relationships between EYPUK and other NCs and international bodies both individually and through international governance;
- Decision making with the rest of the Committee leadership;
- Gathering statistics about EYPUK's work alongside the events teams and updating our records, and furthermore, helping EYPUK to utilise this data in external communications.
